

## HOW TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION FOR SUBSCRIPTION SHARE FORM

Forward the completed Application for Subscription Shares to the registered office:

Please complete all relevant sections of the Registration Form using block letters.

- A** Enter the full name/s and title/s of all legal entities to be recorded as the registered holder/s. Refer to the name standards below for guidance on valid registration.
- Unless advised to the contrary, for joint holdings, the first named applicant is the person to whom correspondence will be addressed and who will have the right to vote on behalf of shareholders.**
- B** Enter the postal address for all communications with the Co-operative. Only one address should be recorded.
- C** Enter a telephone number and a contact person that the Co-operative can speak to if they have any queries regarding this application.
- D** In the case of an individual, enter your tax file number (TFN) or exemption number. For partnerships or joint applications TFN's must be supplied for ALL applicants.
- The rules relating to TFN's provide that every investment which pays a dividend can have the investor's TFN for exemption recorded.
- Collection of TFN's is authorised and strictly regulated by taxation laws and the Privacy Act. Declining to quote a TFN is not an offence and will not invalidate an application for shares. Failure to provide a TFN may result in tax being deducted from the unfranked portion of any dividends paid on shares issued upon the exercise of options at the highest marginal rate plus medicare levy.
- E** For joint applications only the first named applicant is required to sign the share application form. For individual or joint applications, insert the full name of the person signing the form in the signature section.
- F** For a company application, insert the company's name and complete under seal.

### Correct Forms of Registrable Title

Only legal entities may be registered as holders of the shares. Registrations must be in the name/s of natural persons, or legal entities. Shares **cannot** be registered in the name of a partnership, trust, business or trading names or the name of your farm.

The name of a beneficiary or any other name for identification purposes may be included by way of <ACCOUNT TITLE> if completed exactly as described in the examples below.

<b>Individual</b> <i>Use given names in full, not initials</i>	MR JOHN ALFRED SMITH	J A Smith
<b>Company</b> <i>Use company title, not abbreviations</i>	ABC PTY LTD ACN: 000 000 000	ABC P/L or ABC Co
<b>Trust</b> <i>Use the trustee/s names, not the name of the trust</i>	MRS SUSAN JANE SMITH <SUE SMITH FAMILY TRUST>	Sue Smith Family Trust
<b>Deceased estate</b> <i>Use the executor/s personal names, not the name of the deceased</i>	MS JANE MARY SMITH & MR FRANK WILLIAM SMITH <EST. JOHN SMITH A/C>	Estate of late John Smith or John Smith Deceased
<b>Partnership or Joint Application</b> <i>Use the full names of all partners or joint applicants</i>	MR JOHN ROBERT SMITH AND MR MICHAEL JOHN SMITH	John Smith and Son
<b>Superannuation fund</b> <i>Use the name of the trustees, not the name of the fund</i>	JANE SMITH PTY LTD <SUPER FUND A/C>	Jane Smith Pty Ltd Superannuation Fund
